 - ☐ Uses keywords from the job description.
 - ☐ Clearly demonstrates the value you will bring to the employer.
 - ☐ Is concise (2–4 sentences).
 - ☐ Is free of grammar and spelling errors.

Rather than using the same resume objective for every application, customize yours by matching the employer's project type, emphasizing your most relevant leadership accomplishments, and incorporating keywords from the job posting.
